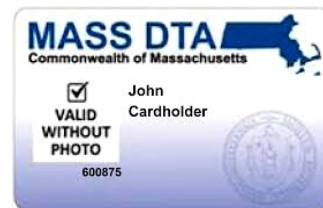


# Get More Food with SNAP!

SNAP Income Eligibility Limits - Oct. 1, 2020, through Sept. 30, 2021

- This table shows the income you must meet in order to receive SNAP. The numbers listed may change yearly.
- In most cases, your total household income must be at or below the gross (total) income level.
- Gross income is how much money everyone in your household makes, total.
